What did we raise?

This term we raised a whopping £1591 from our past events and fundraised. Thank you for all your support!

- Easter Bingo / raffle ticket sales raised a whopping **£343** thanks to everyone for supporting these events and the companies who donated prizes.
- We raised **£272** using crowd funding at rocket.fund to purchase a road sign, Rainhill Rotary Club donated £167 of this, we are very grateful to them, the remainder was donated by friends, family and staff at St Anne's.
- **£267** was received anonymously from a school parent to pay for one road sign, we were shocked beyond words and so extremely grateful!
- Mothers day cards very kindly made by Anita Knowles raised **£109** all of which Anita donated to school. Thank you Anita!
- The sponsored read raised a HUGE **£500** - our children are unbelievable!
- AVS have donated £100 towards the costs of signs. Thank you so much AVS!

What is the money being spent on?

As a parent / carer it is nice to support the school but it is even better to know where your money is being spent and how it is helping the school.

With the money we have managed to raise this term we will be using some of it for the following:

- 2 cartoon style 'No Parking' signs
- 3 'No Parking' signs printed using the winning designs from the competition

- At the end of term the Easter Bunny will be making an appearance and each child will be given a small easter egg from the PTFA
