This term when I look in your books and visit your lessons I would

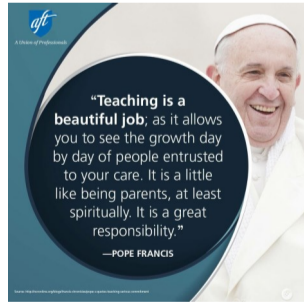


Examples of learning about the Other Faiths of Judaism and Islam and preparations for Advent.
