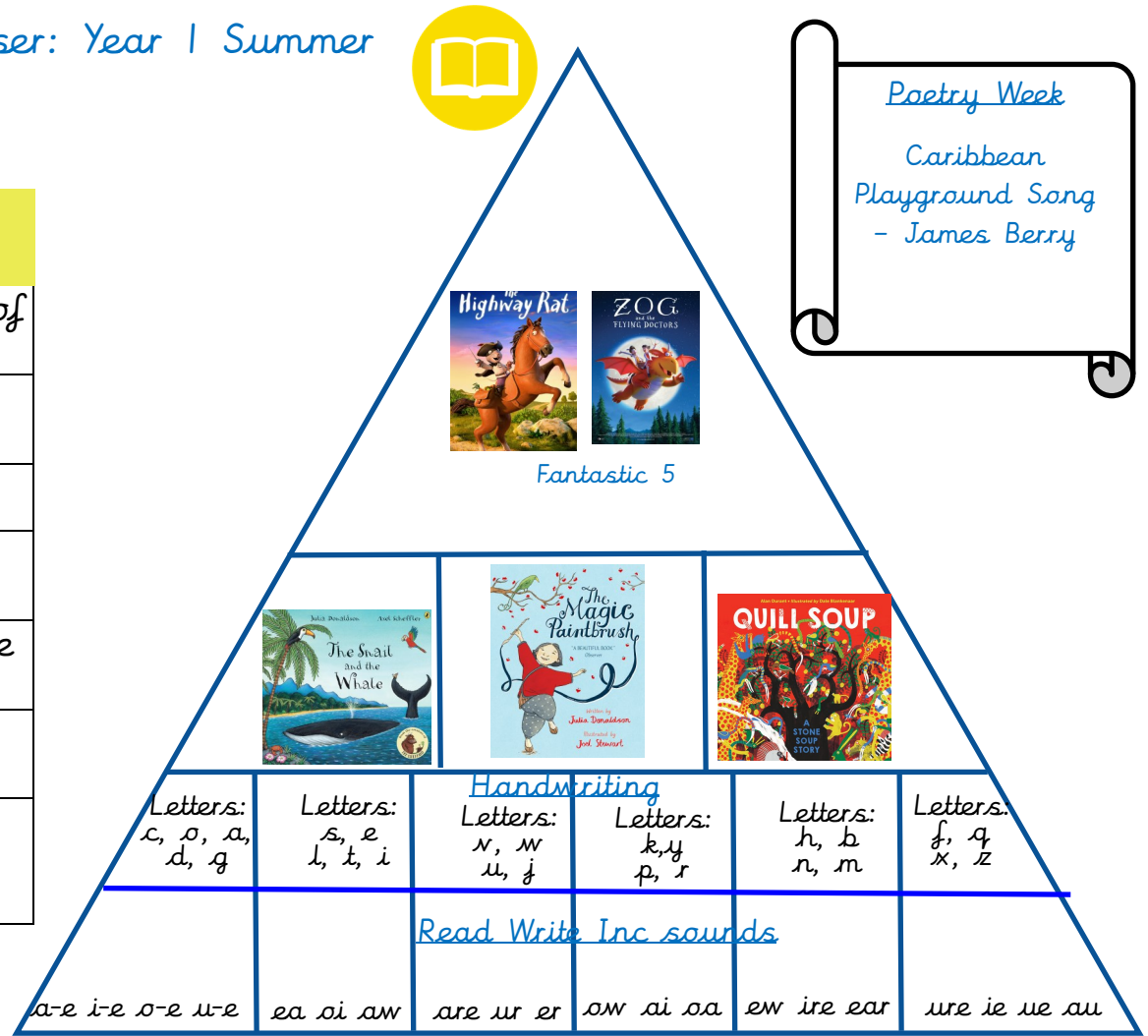

Words	that will help me....
Capital letter	An upper case letter at the start of a sentence or for proper nouns
Full stop	The punctuation at the end of a sentence
Finger space	The spaces between words
Sentence	A set of words that makes up a complete thought
Special friends	Two or three letters that make one sound.
Question mark	? A punctuation mark showing that the sentence is a question
Exclamation mark	! A punctuation mark showing that something is loud or surprising.
