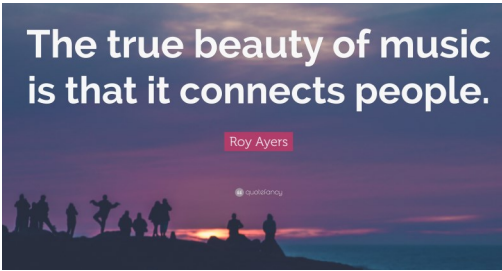


### Thoughts about my Subject:
